ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CAPTAINS

The Danish Aliens Act section 13, subsections 8 and 9 proclaim that

- Yacht captains that arrive in a Danish port from a country, which has not joined the Schengen Convention, must prepare a record of crewmembers and any passengers.
- The record must be submitted to the harbour master upon arrival and will be handed over to the police as a means for preparation of the entry control.
- The record of crewmembers and any passengers of the vessel must contain information concerning name (surname, given name), date of birth (day, month, year) and nationality.
- The information must be handed over in the forms provided by the international maritime organisation IMO concerning crewmembers and passengers (FAL forms no. 5 and 6).

A breach may result in punishment in the form of a fine or incarceration.
